### The theme for this year's Earth Day - Our Power Our Planet

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This year, Earth Day was celebrated with great enthusiasm at MIS on 22 April, with a series of vibrant and meaningful activities aimed at raising awareness about environmental conservation.

The celebration began with an informative and inspiring Earth Day video screened for all students. The video highlighted the urgent need to protect our planet and showcased simple steps individuals can take to make a difference. From climate change and pollution to sustainable living and the power of planting trees, the video sparked meaningful discussions in classrooms and set the tone for the rest of the day.

Following the video, students from various grades took part in an engaging activity where they studied and documented different species of plants growing on the campus. They participated in a "Green Discovery Walk" with a special focus on exploring and appreciating the plant life within the school compound. With notebooks in hand, they observed and studied various species of plants — from flowering shrubs and herbs to towering trees.

Guided by their teachers, students ventured into the school garden and surrounding green areas, observing trees, shrubs, herbs, and flowering plants. They noted each plant's characteristics, such as leaf shape, height, type of flower, and whether the plant was native or ornamental. Some students even researched the medicinal uses and environmental benefits of the species they found. They also created a QR code where the students can scan and access the information whenever they need it.

The activity not only sparked curiosity about biodiversity but also helped students understand the importance of plants in maintaining ecological balance. Later, students presented their findings through colourful charts, leaf journals, and short presentations.

This hands-on experience for the students helped strengthen their bond with nature and the celebrations reminded everyone of the role plants play in keeping our Earth healthy and alive.
